### Volumes up but yields down for world air cargo

Yields for air cargo carriers continued to decline in April this year, despite worldwide volumes increasing by 3.3% compared to the same period last year.

Latest data by air cargo analyst, WorldACD, showed that April yields – measured in US dollars – had dropped by 11% compared to January this year.

WorldACD noted on its website that, in line with regular seasonal patterns, worldwide volumes in April were almost 6% lower than in March. The notable exception was the origin Asia Pacific where volumes remained the same month-over-month (MoM).

In terms of volumes, Europe was the fastest growing origin in percentage terms, registering a year-on-year increase of 4.1%, while North America was the best performing destination with an increase of 12.6% on a year ago.
