### Line reliability on three main trades improves

The aggregate on-time performance of services operating Asia-Europe, transpacific and transatlantic routes was 67.6% in April, a rise of 4.1% from the previous month, according to Drewry's monthly Carrier Performance Insight.

This was a new high since the start of data series in May 2014, and beat the 64.3% reliability rating achieved on the three trades last October.

With congestion on the previously strike-bound US west coast ports having eased in April after the strike ended, the transpacific trade saw the biggest improvement, according to Drewry, with on-time reliability up 15.1% to 54%.

Meanwhile, in terms of individual carrier reliability, it was Maersk Line that once again held on to the top spot in Drewry's rankings, posting an 85% performance rating, followed by OOCL with 77% reliability and MOL and NYK both on 74%.
