‘Proposed travel restrictions would close the country down’

The freight road transport travel restrictions – devised in all her wisdom by minister of transport, Elizabeth Dipuo Peters – are set to ruin the industry and its clients, according to Carl Webb, MD of Project Logistics Management (PLM) and adviser on abnormal cartage to the Road Freight Association (RFA) and the SA Association of Freight Forwarders (Saaff).

He suggested to FTW that “our resident genius in charge of transport” restricting heavy vehicle travel hours between 06h00-09h00 and 17h00-20h00 would effectively lose the transport industry six hours a day, or 25% of capacity.
