Second Kenyan port terminal may open early

Construction of the second container terminal at the Port of Mombasa may be completed early, according to news reports.

A spokesperson for the Kenya Ports Authority (KPA) was cited by Kenya's The Star newspaper as saying that the first phase of the US\$280m terminal was expected to be completed a month or two earlier than the scheduled March 2016 opening date.

The terminal will increase the capacity of the port from 1.1m TEUs to 1.55m TEUs. This would increase to 2.3m TEU by 2019.

According to KPA's head of corporate affairs Beranard Osero, the bidders' conference has already taken place and twelve firms are in the running to operate the terminal including China Merchant Holdings, DP World and APM Terminals.

The bid winner will be selected in September 2015
